## 15 years ineligibility for horse trainer Fabrice Souloy

The Norwegian Trotting Association's (DNT) adjudication panel has found horse trainer Fabrice Souloy guilty in an intentional violation of DNT's anti-doping rules, after the racehorses Your Highness, Un Mec d'Heripre, Lionel and Timone Ek tested positive for Cobalt in blood- or urine samples immediately after racing at Bjerke Racetrack on June 12<sup>th</sup>, 2016.

Fabrice Souloy was given the following sanctions:

- 1. A 15 year period of ineligibility, involving;
  - loss of right to any training or driving license issued by The Norwegian Trotting Association,
  - loss of right to participate in any trotting races,
  - loss of right to visit or use any training or racing facility owned or financed by The Norwegian Trotting Association.
- 2. A fine of 500 000 NOK.
- 3. The period of ineligibility will take effect immediately.

The verdict was unanimous.
